# **Our story**



"Most outstanding STEM event I have ever been a part of!" EAARO, exhibitor Peterborough STEM Festival showcases and celebrates the world of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics through free-to-attend events and fun activities throughout the year.

We aim to promote awareness of opportunities in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) to young people and their families through community events, collaborations and meaningful partnerships.

Our first STEM Festival in 2016 hosted 500 attendees, which has successfully grown year on year, with our most recent festival hosting over 4000 STEM adventurers and their families. The average time spent on-site is a whopping 5 hours!

Our audience is school-aged children, young adults considering apprenticeships or higher education, and parents and educators in STEM and our core aim is to encourage children, particularly girls and young women, into STEM subjects and careers.

The target age for our workshops and activities for our main family day is 5-14 years; however, we encourage all ages to attend our events alongside their STEM Adventurers!

The Festival was conceived and founded in 2016 by the organisers of the non-profit organisation, Digital People in Peterborough CIC (DPiP), who are proud to have been a part of Peterborough's digital community for over twelve years.

# Inspiring girls



"I learned that turtles breathe through their bums." STEM Adventurer Logan, age 10 Our founder, Tia Lush, was introduced to a 19th-century mathematician, writer and one of the world's first computer programmers, Ada Lovelace, after visiting an Ada Lovelace Day event. Ada Lovelace Day is an international event celebrating the achievements of women in Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM).

Tia returned inspired and decided to set up a local festival that personifies the Finding Ada Network. The festival aims to honour Ada's achievements, champion present-day women working in STEM careers, and inspire and encourage future generations into these careers.

**"Female pupils were less likely to rank a STEM-related subject first for enjoyment: 32% compared to 59% of males**", Attitudes towards STEM subjects by gender, Department for Education, 2019.

Of course, we don't exclude any genders; so the Peterborough STEM Festival hopes to inspire all young people (and their grown-ups too!)

We achieve inspiration in STEM through a jam-packed day of fun, handson learning activities and talks from pioneering speakers. Our goal is to sow a seed in young minds to take an interest in STEM subjects that could help them literally reach the stars.

#### Augusta Ada King-Noel, Countess of Lovelace

Augusta Ada King-Noel, Countess of Lovelace (commonly known as Ada Lovelace), was an English mathematician and writer chiefly known for her work on Charles Babbage's proposed mechanical general-purpose computer, the Analytical Engine.

In the mid-1800s Ada was the first person to recognise that the machine had applications beyond pure calculation and published the first algorithm intended to be carried out by such a machine.

As a result, she is sometimes regarded as the first to recognise the full potential of a "computing machine" and the first computer programmer.

Ada Lovelace Day, founded by social technologist Suw Charman-Anderson, has become an international week of celebration of women in STEM, with events taking place worldwide.

Peterborough STEM Festival is proud to be recognised as an official Ada Lovelace event.


#### City pop-up events



# 2024 Budget

As you can appreciate, hosting these events costs money to cover such things as venue hire, security, promotional expenses like printed media and merchandise, prizes for the STEM Adventurers attending and a whole plethora of extra other things that require payment, not excluding the all important bunting!

As organisers we wish to remain open about such costs so below is a general idea of what our target minimum budget is to host the main festival day and include a Friday setup day for all exhibitors to benefit from.

### Main Festival Family Day + setup day

We have over £15,400 worth of support value already through design, marketing, expert advice and venue access for some of our fringe events. Our minimum budget required for this event is **£50,000**. Through our exhibitor packages detailed on page 12 we hope to raise funds to cover this so our events can remain free and open to all young visitors and their families regardless of their backgrounds and financial situations.
